## GENERAL CONDITIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS: -

- a)** The application forms of students belonging to B.Pharm. I-VII duly signed by the students and the Principal of the concerned college along with a photocopy of qualifying examination should be submitted to the examination branch before the last date. The delay in submission after the last date will attract penalty (Rs.1000/-) Xerox copy of photograph will not be considered.

**b)** Application forms of students belonging to B.Pharmacy VIII semester should be accompanied with all the memos of previous semesters (i. e I-VII sem.)
- The Principal is requested to remit the examination fee (consolidated amount) for received application forms only. Any excess fee paid will not be refunded.
- The Principal is requested to verify and forward all the application forms of the students along with the Name List (Nominal Roll) in the prescribed proforma (Consisting name, Father's & Mother's name, Gender, Category and the theory and practical papers registered for the exams), subject wise data & fee particulars in duplicate.
- Not to collect the Exam fee from Blind, differently abled , hearing in students. A Xerox Copy of Medical Certificate confirming their status as Handicapped (minimum percentage of disability must be of 40%) must be attached to the Application forms. Application forms of these Students should be submitted separately with a Separate Nominal Roll.**
- All the students are hereby instructed to deposit Examination fee into their respective College Principal's Accounts only (students are advised not to obtain the DD in favour of the Controller of Examinations, PU)
- The concerned Principal's are requested to transfer the fee amount through RTGS / NEFT for credit into **Registrar, Palamuru University Exam Fee Fund A/c No. 62078258948 (SBI, Ganesh Nagar Branch, Mahabubnagar, IFSCCode "SBIN0016375")** and obtain a receipt from the bank and submit the same to the Examination Branch, PU along with application forms. No Demand Drafts are accepted at Exam Branch.
