**Internal Assessment, Commerce Lab, Seminar and Project Work Examinations of PG II & IV – Semester (Regular/Backlog) and (III-Semester Backlogs of 2018-20 Batch students only) & M.Sc. 5 years Integrated Chemistry Semester-II, IV, VI, VIII and X semester (Regular/Backlog/Improvement) and IX Semester (Backlog for the 2015-20 Batch only)**

## **EXAMINATIONS**

All the P.G. (CBCS) & M.Sc. 5 Years Integrated Chemistry College Principals are hereby informed that the following details are to be noted for the submission of Internal Assessment, Commerce Lab, Seminar and Project Work Examinations of PG II & IV – Semester (Regular/Backlog) and III-Semester Backlogs and M.Sc. 5 years Integrated Chemistry Semester-II, IV, VI, VIII and X semester (Regular/Backlog/Improvement) and IX Semester (Backlog) (CBCS) Semester for the academic year 2019-20.

1. PG II & IV-Semester (Regular/Backlog) & III-Semester (Backlog) and M.Sc. 5 years Integrated Chemistry Semester-II, IV, VI, VIII and X semester (Regular/Backlog/Improvement) and IX Semester (Backlog) Commerce Lab, Seminar Examinations will have to be conducted with the internal examiners for this spell on or before 22-10-2020.
2. Project work examination will have to be conducted as per the BOS guidelines of concerned subjects on or before 22-10-2020.
3. For the subjects where the first internal examination is completed and second is due and the student who has written the first internal has to submit an assignment with answers to two essay type questions from each unit which are not covered for the first internal exam. Students who have failed to attend the first internal will have to submit two assignments with answers to two essay type questions from each unit. Colleges have to submit best of two internal marks on or before 22-10-2020.
4. Maximum internal assessment marks for all students of all PG courses is 20.
5. Absent should be noted as "AB"
6. Principals will be held responsible for entries made on the award list for all the examinations held at colleges.
7. Marks submitted by the college are final and there is no provision for alteration.
8. Hard copies of all the examinations and internal assignments award list along with manual D-Form should be submitted to the exam branch on or before 27-10-2020. If not submitted, fine will be imposed after the due date.
9. All colleges must follow the COVID-19 safety measures, while conducting all the above mentioned examinations.
10. Any discrepancies in the above circular should be brought to the notice of the undersigned within 2 days.
